HOW SAFE IS CAMP?

- Camp is conducted and supervised by qualified adults.
- The Pearland Town Center is a DDACTS area for the Pearland Police Department, providing constant security to ensure their goal of a safe community is maintained.
- We have a professionally installed indoor/outdoor camera system with cloud monitoring capabilities. Doors remained locked in our lobby area at all times.

WHAT IS YOUR STAFF SELECTION PROCESS?

- Thorough criminal background checks are conducted on all employees.
- · Adult employees are either certified, degreed, or highly experienced to care for and teach children. High school co-op students are trained and overseen by an adult.
- Psychological tests and evaluations are also performed to ensure that students are paired with loving, patient, and mentally stable mentors and instructors.



HOW IS OUTSIDE TIME HANDLED?

- Campers will enjoy various outdoor games and activities during non-peak mall hours.
- Campers will be guided by two trained camp coaches to lead campers safely to a designated grass or pavilion area for activities.



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WHAT ARE THE CAMPER/COACH RATIOS?

- Rising 1st-3rd and Rising 4th-6th grade campers will be in groups of 10/1.
- There are times when campers may be grouped together during a seated presentation with a ratio of 30-40 campers/and 4-6 camp coaches.

IS LUNCH PROVIDED?

- Lunch is provided.
- Campers may bring their own lunch that does not require heating.
- Campers may bring their own snack, however, we will provide an individually prepackaged snack.

HOW ARE FIELD TRIPS COMMUNICATED?

- A welcome packet will be provided before the first week of camp with field trip details
- Field trips are free and will be held on Fridays. This summer, field trips will be local.
- Camper will need to purchase a T-shirt to wear on field trip days. The shirts are \$15



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WHAT WILL MY CHILD DO AT CAMP?

- We have daily agendas preplanned, starting at 7:30a-6:00p for every camp day.
- Your camper will be busy moving from one activity to the next, in groups, individually or in pairs, depending on the activity or project goal.
- Activity areas will range from STEM, Art, Coding, Robotics, Fitness, Kids Biz Projects, and much more.
